International enrolment for academic year 2025 scholarship is available for international students that meet the following requirements:

- Full 1 year enrolment.
- To begin Term 1, 2025 (starting date 1 Feb 2025) OR Term 3, 2025 (starting date 14 July 2025 or before)
- Year 9 or Year 10 only (14 -15 years old)
- Application MUST be received by:
 - 30th November 2024 to begin enrolment for February 2025 academic term
 - 11th April 2025 to begin enrolment for July/August 2025 academic term
- Scholarship details: \$1,000 NZD reduction of tuition fee

- Be a current citizen of Thailand.
- Be enrolling for a minimum period of 1 year (4 terms).
- Be willing to contribute to the wider life of the school.
- Must have commenced the enrolment process at Papatoetoe High School.
